Responding to the double challenge of malaria and COVID-19

Malaria is a potentially life-threatening disease caused by infection with Plasmodium protozoa transmitted by an infective female Anopheles mosquito. Plasmodium falciparum infection carries a poor prognosis with a high mortality if untreated, but it has an excellent prognosis if diagnosed early and treated appropriately.

1. Name and nature of infecting organism. Malaria is an acute or subacute infectious disease caused by one of four protozoan species of the genus Plasmodium: P. falciparum, P. vivax, P. ovale, or P. malariae, mainly transmitted by Anopheles mosquitoes. Occasionally, transmission occurs by blood transfusion, organ transplantation, needle-sharing, or congenitally from mother to foetus.
